Turkey Supper Food Donations

Starting out we need to sort out who is planning on contributing specific food, or money to buy turkeys, so we can make calls for the rest of the food we need. Here is what we are looking for:

- **Homemade Pies** – we are looking for 50 people to make 2 HOMEMADE pies each.
- **Homemade Rolls** - if you are one of the select few that actually enjoy making rolls please sign up.
- **Food Donations** – Food donation lists are posted in the narthex for you to sign up for whatever you wish to bring. Please take note of the quantity/package size for the item you are contributing.
- **Phone Callers** – We need a few people to make calls for the remainder of the food items that are not assigned signed up for. If you can help by making a few calls, please sign up or speak to Pat Galbraith.

- **Sponsor a Turkey** – We purchase the biggest birds in town! Each turkey costs approximately \$40, but any contribution would be appreciated. Sign up on the poster or speak to Henry Ellsworth.
- **Turkey Cookers** – Those 23 big turkeys all need to be cooked. Please sign up on the poster or let Henry know if you can help in this way.
- **TURKEY PICK UP Sunday Nov 24th** – If you offer to cook a turkey, pick it up right after church the Sunday before the supper, Nov 24th, and return it by 6 pm on Friday, Nov 29th. Make sure you return the drippings too. What is turkey without that delicious gravy!

VEGGIES AND OTHER NON-BAKED GOODS - please bring them in to the kitchen with your name clearly marked on them. Knox kitchen is VERY busy, so we ask that you **wait until the week before the supper** to bring in your donation. If you want to make sure there is someone available to accept your donation, please bring them in at one of the following times:

- **Sunday, Nov 24th**, before or after church
- **Monday to Wednesday, Nov 25th-27th**, between 10 and 2 p.m.
- **Thursday, Nov 28th**, between 10 and 2 p.m. or 6 and 8 p.m.
- **Friday, Nov 29th**, any time before 6 p.m.

BAKED GOODS - pies and rolls for the supper can be brought in the night before or the morning of the supper. Please note that if you signed up to bring pies or rolls, we will not be making follow-up calls, but rest assured we still need your delicious donation!!
